Condition Report

400. Generally good order. Both have small splits near to bases, but otherwise ok. Silver rims are a little worn and hallmarks a little rubbed, but not significant damage or repairs. One rim is solidly fixed, the other is slightly looser where it appears one pin fixing has come loose, so there is a little bit of play.
