A late 19th/early 20th century Chinese silver three-piece tea set, comprising teapot, milk jug and two-handled sugar bowl and cover, each oval body decorated in relief with a dragon on a stippled ground band, maker's mark of Tuck Chang & Co of Shanghai to bases, weight 1045g, length of teapot 26cm.

Estimate: £500 - £800

Condition Report

Each piece is monogram engraved 'DG'.

The three pieces overall are in good condition with no repairs and only typical minor and light surface wear and a few minor dents/bruises.

The teapot is missing one smoke trail from the dragons left nostril.

The sugar bowl has a slightly rough finish to its rim.

Good clear marks to each piece.
