A Chinese blue and white porcelain vase, late 19th century, the tapering body and flared neck painted with two dragons amidst peony, height 38cm (hairline crack to rim and body).

Condition Report

The vase appears to be in good condition, however there is a 5cm vertical hairline crack to the rim, there is also a faint hairline to the body which runs from the shoulder to just over halfway down the body, approx 20cm long. Otherwise the colours are bright and vibrant with no chips or restoration.
