A Chinese blue and white export porcelain miniature vase, Kangxi period, the baluster body painted with arched Long Eliza panels, underglaze blue leaf mark to base, height 8.1cm, together with a Chinese underglaze blue and red porcelain snuff bottle of cylindrical form, painted with two figures beneath a tree, height 8cm (hairline to body), and a blue and white snuff bottle, painted with Buddhist lions, height 8cm (hairline crack to body).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

Kangxi bottle - in good condition overall, no chips, cracks or restoration.

Red and blue bottle - hairline crack which runs across the foot and approx 3.5cm vertically up the body of the bottle, otherwise in good order.

Buddhistic Lion bottle - hairline crack running from shoulder diagonally down the bottle, approx 4.5cm, small iron oxide glaze blemish to footrim, otherwise ok.
