Two Chinese Canton export ivory tangram puzzle boxes, mid-19th century, each of square outline, one sliding cover carved and pierced with figures beneath a tree, the other with a fenghuang (phoenix), each containing seven pierced puzzle pieces, widths 5.5cm and 5.6cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £50 - £100

Condition Report

Both games are complete - there is some variation to the colour of some of the ivory pieces, suggesting some of the pieces may be replacements, some may have some little nibbles. The figural cover has a hole to the pierced trelliswork.
