A Japanese Satsuma earthenware cylindrical box and cover by Kinkozan, Meiji period, the cover moulded in low relief with a square panel, painted and gilt with a maiden and two children reserved against a polychrome and gilt foliate ground, gilt signature seal to base, diameter 8cm, height 3.5cm.

Condition Report

Typical fine crazing to glaze. Minute nick to inner rim edge of base which is hidden when cover is in place. Otherwise no cracks or restoration and in good condition overall with very minor wear to enamels and gilding, nothing untoward.
