Three pieces of Japanese Fukagawa Imari porcelain, Meiji/Taisho period, each painted and gilt with irises, comprising an ovoid vase, height 10.2cm, a vase of flattened circular form, height 10.2cm, and a two-handled sugar bowl and cover, height 10.8cm, all with underglaze blue factory mark to base.

## Condition Report

Ovoid vase - generally in good condition, minor enamel loss to one yellow petal, otherwise typical light surface scratches and wear.

Circular vase - good condition, typical light surface scratches and wear.

Sugar bowl and cover - faint starcrack to base, otherwise in good condition with only typical light surface scratches and wear.
