A Japanese underglaze blue and red porcelain teapot and cover by Makuzu Kozan, Meiji period, the oval body moulded in relief with pinkish red and purple carp leaping from and above blue and white waves, all below clouds and vapours rising to a pierced rim, the cover with carp finial, moulded six-character mark to base, height 15cm (damage to pierced rim and handle repaired).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

The handle has been broken off and re-glued, the pierced gallery has some chips and losses, otherwise the body and spout appear to be in good order. The cover has a small chip to the rim, and one end has been broken and re-glued.
