A Japanese Satsuma earthenware vase, Meiji period, the slightly tapered cylindrical body painted and gilt with opposing panels of samurai warriors in a battle scene and a gathering of arhats in a landscape, below a relief moulded dragon to shoulder, unsigned, height 25cm (chips to dragon).

Condition Report

Generally in good condition, typical light crazing. Some minor chips to the dragon including the horns, claws and beard. Otherwise no significant damage or repairs. There is a faint hairline to the footrim. Enamels and gilt with only very minor wear.
