A Chinese Nanking Cargo blue and white porcelain tea bowl and saucer, Qianlong period, painted with the pine tree pattern, saucer diameter 10.3cm, together with a Nanking Cargo cup, painted and gilt with chrysanthemum and rocks, height 7cm, each applied with a Nanking Cargo paper label to base.

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

1097. Nanking blue and white tea bowl - generally good condition but there is a very faint 3mm hairline to the rim, a couple of tiny rim nibbles and a small chip to footrim.

Saucer - good condition, a few minor nibbles to rim but no significant damage or repairs.

Cup - small chip to rim and wear to enamels, but otherwise good condition.
