A Chinese export silver filigree oval etui case, late Qing dynasty, of oval section with hinged lid, the sides worked in relief with a panel of squirrel amidst fruiting vines, reserved against whorl borders, height 12.5cm (some minor losses).

## Condition Report

1028. The hinge is slightly wobbly, but the lid closes tightly. There are some small areas of loss to the filigree background on both sides particularly around the edge of the base. Loss to some of the beading on the borders. Most of this damage/loss can be seen in the images on our website where a magnification option enhances the images further as required.
