A pair of Japanese cloisonné vases, 20th century, each of shouldered ovoid form with flared neck, decorated with panels of birds, butterflies and flowers on different speckled grounds, reserved against a black border filled with foliate scrolls, on a circular foot, height 16cm, together with a pair of Chinese cloisonné enamel birds, length 7cm.

Estimate: £60 - £100

### Condition Report

1228. Pair of vases - both in generally good condition with no cracks or repairs. One has a small dent to the edge of base, which makes it wobble slightly. Otherwise enamel and decoration is in good order with only typical light surface scratches and wear.

Both birds in good condition.
