A 19th century Indian tulwar with overall gold damascened decoration, the slightly inward curved single-edged blade with pierced 'Tears of Allah' back, blade length 72cm, the iron handle with elephant's head pommel and tiger knucklebow, both the elephant and tiger with inset coloured stone eyes (overall rusty and worn surface, lacking scabbard).

2460. Structurally the sword is ok, with no movement to the blade and hilt joint. The blade had a few small nicks to the edge. The end of the blade is slightly bent and there is overall surface rust and pitting.
