A late 18th/early 19th century flintlock pistol by Philip Bond, bearing maker's mark to lock, with octagonal barrel, barrel length 11.5cm, engraved trigger guard, chequered grip and pull-out ramrod, together with an associated 19th century style reproduction powder flask.

Condition Report

2465. The lock plate is sitting slightly away from the stock at its rear point. There are some very minor nicks to the edges of the stock, overall surface pitting and rust to metalware and the ramrod appears to be a later well made replacement. The pistol cocks and holds in both positions with springs feeling sound enough.
