A William IV mahogany extending pull-out dining table, in the manner of Gillows of Lancaster, the moulded rectangular top with three extra leaves, raised on reeded tapering legs and brass castors, height 72cm, extended length 255cm, depth 130cm.

Estimate: £600 - £1,000

Condition Report

2010. Overall condition is generally quite good with some sun fading to one of the frieze and legs, but the top is fairly unaffected. There is some very slight warping to the edge of the top but really only a slight ripple. The edge of the top has had some in-fills where the original clip holders would have fitted. One leaf is slightly darker than the other two but otherwise the table is structurally sound and is a good useable piece. Length without leaves 118cm.
