2140. Both chairs are structurally sound and have the usual surface wear, scuffs and marks. One chair has a well-repaired crack to the handrest. The other chair has some old woodworm along the edge of the right arm and throughout one stretcher. It also has a slight chip off the rear corner of one of the rear legs.
