LOT 1386

A small group of Chinese pottery, including a flambé glazed bottle vase, height 15cm, a sancai glazed figure, 20th century, and two bowls (cracked), together with four Chinese hardwood stands (faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Flambe vase - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Typical light crazing particularly to neck.

Sancai figure - generally in good condition, typical scuffs and wear.

Whiteware bowl - chip to rim with a 1.5cm crack running down from that point and a 5.5cm crack to the other side of the rim. The bowl is slightly misshapen, has some discolouration, scratches and wear.

Other bowl - in poor condition with glaze loss to interior and exterior - possibly has been submerged - also cracked, chipped, worn and crazed with some discolouration.

Four wood stands - generally in good condition with minor nicks/chips, one more worn than the others.
