Condition Report

Hat - some wear to the velvet brim and inner edge, the purple silk in generally good order. The glass finial has a small bruise to one side and typical light surface scratches, otherwise good.

Cap - in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs.

Plume - appears to be in good condition, the outer paper sleeve is worn and creased. The silk case has significant wear to the top and bottom with some losses to the top and edge.

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
