A George III and later mahogany 'D' end twin-pedestal dining table, the top inlaid in ebony with a wide Greek key border and fitted with a later matching leaf, raised on downswept tripod supports and brass castors, height 70cm, extended length 177cm, depth 146cm (alterations).

Condition Report

2068. General condition and appearance is fairly good. It was probably fully restored when the later 20th century central leaf was made. There are some surface cracks across the borders of both ends, where the carcass wood has moved slightly. Otherwise the general surface is quite good with a few small minor repairs. Both pedestals appear to be sound and all four clips are present.
