A Japanese Satsuma earthenware vase, Meiji period, of slender tapering form, painted and gilt with a standing maiden, unmarked, height 21cm, together with a Japanese Satsuma earthenware moonflask, height 12.5cm.

Condition Report

1016. Slender Satsuma vase - generally good condition with typical light crazing and minor wear to enamels and gilt. However, the footrim has been slightly ground down, presumably where there were some small chips. Moonflask - in good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Minor chip to underside of foot. Some wear to gilt and enamels. Typical light crazing.
