A pair of 19th century French mother-of-pearl and gilt metal opera glasses, the eyepieces inscribed 'Raphael Opticien...', width 11.8cm, a mid-19th century brass and leather bound telescope by Dolland, London, bearing presentation plaque, inscribed 'Presented... 1847 to Gentleman Cadet D.J. Nasmyth by... East India Company...', and another telescope, detailed 'The Hawk'.

2555. The 19th century telescope has a dent to the eyepiece, but when fully drawn you can see clearly and in focus.

The 'Hawk' telescope has some wear to its case, but is also in working order.

The opera glasses are in fair condition.
