A pair of early 20th century Continental Neoclassical Revival green fluorite and cast ormolu mounted ornamental urns and covers, the pierced covers above fluted bodies raised on triform supports with mask terminals and entwined serpents, height 54.5cm (lacking one foot).

Condition Report

2594. One of the lids has a dent to the rim. The stand is missing one screw and the main body appears to have been re-fixed to the mounts and turned slightly at some stage, as there are three small filled-in holes to the sides. The other is lacking one of the feet on the base, has a small chip and repair to its circular hardstone base. Otherwise both have some quite minor surface nicks and typical internal fractures to the stone.
