A Victorian bloodstone set watch key, mounted with a rectangular bloodstone, length 4.5cm, a slide action toothpick with a red paste seal terminal, length extended 5.5cm, and a gilt metal propelling pencil.

Estimate: £40 - £60

Condition Report

Watch key – split at key end to the gold covering, key itself no longer of square section and is missing the end.

Toothpick – is converted from a small pencil, centre section is a bit bent and stained.

Propelling Pencil – loss of mechanism at the front of the pencil, test mark to the top shows that it is gilt metal.
