LOT 671

A gold and citrine brooch, designed as a trefoil, detailed '9ct', width 2g, a 9ct gold, seed pearl and yellow gem set bar brooch, Chester 1906 (two seed pearls lacking), an oval tiger's eye brooch, an oval carved jet brooch, fitted with a safety chain, and a silver brooch, Birmingham 1911.

Estimate: £70 - £90

Condition Report

All would benefit from professional cleaning.

Citrine trefoil brooch – in good condition.

Yellow stone brooch – two seed pearls lacking.

Tiger's eye brooch – dent to rim by hinge, would benefit from cleaning, hinge pin rather bent.

Jet brooch – glue visible at the back connecting the jet to the panel of the brooch pin fitting, one or two chips to the edge of the jet and to the central rim.

Silver brooch – dented and hole by the hinge end, swallow a bit distorted.

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
