### Condition Report

Both in good condition overall with no significant damage or repairs. Hallmarks rubbed but readable. Both shells engraved with an armorial.

The rim edge of one of the shells has some minor misshaping where the edge is turned over in a few spots, this is seen less so on the other shell. The other shell does have a minor dent to the side edge of the handle by the hallmark.
