## LOT 345

An early 20th century German silver cow creamer, modelled standing with tail forming the handle, the hinged lid cast with a fly, import mark Chester 1901 by Berthold Muller, weight 168g, length 14.4cm, height 7.5cm.

## Condition Report

The cow looks as though it has probably been dropped at some stage as the back right leg has a stress crack across the top of the upper thigh and the whole leg is subsequently at an angle, the tail has a similar stress crack near the body end which is probably due to the same original potential drop.

The right ear has a small solder repair behind it and an associated minor tear to the top of it.

The horns do not appear damaged but are of slightly differing shape.

The hallmarks are rubbed but readable.
