LOT 532

An 18ct gold, sapphire and diamond ring, claw set with an oval cut and two circular cut sapphires alternating with two circular cut diamonds, Birmingham 1899, weight 5.2g, ring size approx N1/2.

Condition Report

532. The sapphires are of medium to pale colour saturation, the principal sapphire has surface wear and some damage at the end of the table facet and to the facets below that on one side, the other two sapphires have slight signs of wear to the table facet edges. One of the diamonds has a fairly large surface reaching inclusion to the same side as where the principal sapphire is damaged. The diamonds slightly draw colour to grey and have a few internal gletz and piqué inclusions. Hallmark clear. The claws are starting to show signs of wear, some scuff and surface marks to the gold mount, particularly between the principal sapphire and two diamonds. Principal sapphire weight approx 0.30ct, diamond weights approx 0.22ct each stone. Length of top of ring 2.2cm.

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
