A gold ring, claw set with a pear shaped tanzanite between two pairs of circular cut diamonds, detailed '14K', weight 3g, ring size approx M1/2.

Condition Report

606. The tanzanite is of medium colour saturation, one or two signs of very minor wear to the tanzanite facet edges, the side diamonds look to be attractive white stones. The ring would benefit from professional cleaning. The ring is in generally good condition. Width of top of ring approx 8mms, length of tanzanite approx 7mm. Second hand, of fairly modern manufacture. The '14K' stamp would suggest it was made in the Middle East or perhaps America. It is not hallmarked, only stamped '14K'.
