An 18ct platinum and diamond ring, claw set with the principal circular cut diamond between two smaller circular cut diamonds, detailed '18ct Plat', weight 2.1g, ring size approx L1/2, total diamond weight approx 0.30ct.

Condition Report

607. The principal diamond slightly draws colour and has a few internal inclusions, which are not surface reaching. There is slight variation of cut to the side diamonds, they slightly draw colour but look to be fairly clear. Length of top of ring approx 1.1cm. Ring is in good condition. When viewed from the sides the claws appear to have been re-tipped in the past. Suggested age, 1960s.
