LOT 343

An Elizabeth II silver mounted cut glass decanter and stopper, London 1968 by Preece & Williscombe, height 29cm, together with a silver overlay and clear glass jug, the neck with pierced and engraved foliate band, height 15cm.

Estimate: £50 - £100

Condition Report

343. Decanter and stopper - in good condition with no chips or cracks to glass. Silver collar with typical light scratches, but otherwise good with good clear marks.

Jug - in generally good condition, but there is a small star crack to the glass where the neck meets the top of the handle. It is not obviously noticeable because of the location and largely hidden beneath the overlay. The whole area of the crack covers approx 1.5cm. Otherwise the glass is good. The silver overlay is in generally good order with typical light surface wear, it is unmarked.
