A Breguet Type 20 Chronograph steel cased gentleman's wristwatch, circa 1970s, with jewelled Valjoux 725 calibre movement, the signed black dial with luminous Arabic hour numerals and three subsidiary dials, the black anodized rotating bezel detailed 0-60, the case back exterior numbered '20445' and later inscribed 'Labor Omnia Vincit' above 'John A Adamek', case diameter 4.1cm, on a leather strap.

1050. The watch winds and adjusts smoothly and is currently in good working order, and the chronograph features are also working as they should, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Case in generally good condition with typical light surface scratches and wear, but no significant damage or repairs.

It would certainly benefit from a clean as it is a little dirty around inside edge of bezel and around sides of case, beneath buttons etc.

Dial appears to be in good condition with good detail. Glass with typical surface scratches. Bezel with light wear and minor black paint loss to edges. Strap worn.

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
