335. Both jugs are in good condition. Each glass body is in good order with no significant damage, cracks or repairs. Silver mount also in good condition with typical light surface scratches and wear. No significant damage or repairs. Hinges are good and close tightly. Very minor misshaping to inner rims. Each marked '800'.
