A George III mahogany circular wall timepiece with brass four pillar eight day fusee movement, the 12-inch repainted convex dial with black Roman hour numerals, within a moulded circular surround with cast brass bezel and convex glass, the case with hinged doors to side and underside, diameter 36cm, with pendulum.

Condition Report

1111. The timepiece appears to be in good condition with no significant damage or repairs. The dial is repainted. Glass and hinge in good order. Case in good order commensurate with age. Few veneer splits to bow underside and trap door, the moulded circular surround with repaired and restored splits at typical 3 and 9 o'clock with securing backplates added. All of this can be seen in the photographs available on our website. The movement winds smoothly and is currently running but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

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
