### LOT 1102

A mid-19th century mahogany circular wall timepiece with brass eight day single fusee movement, the 12-inch painted convex dial with black Roman hour numerals and inscribed 'W. Dann Maidstone', within a moulded circular surround with cast brass bezel and convex glass, the case box with hinged doors to side and underside, diameter 37cm, with pendulum. Note: W. Dann is recorded in 'Watchmakers and Clockmakers of the World' by Brian Loomes as working in Maidstone between 1826 and 1866.

### Condition Report

1102. The clock appears to be in generally good order with no significant damage or repairs. Glass and hinge in good order, surround and box are sound. The movement winds smoothly and starts running, but only runs for a minute or two before losing power and stopping completely.
