A late Victorian pale oak cased bracket clock with eight day twin fusee movement striking hours on a gong, the brass circular dial with black Roman hour numerals and inscribed 'Halton and Slocombe, 63 Moorgate Street E.C', the case with scroll arched surmount applied with carved shell, flower and foliate mouldings, the sides with bevelled glazed panels, the scroll base with carved floral swag, on a plinth, height 54.5cm, with pendulum, together with matching wall bracket.

Condition Report

1090. The clock is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Glass hinge front dial door and both bevelled glass side panels in good order. The oak case has some typical light surface scratches, scuffs and knocks, but nothing significant and commensurate with age. The clock winds smoothly and is currently working and strikes the hours on a gong, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.
