A George III oak longcase clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the 12-inch painted breakarch dial with rolling moon to arch above subsidiary seconds and date aperture, inscribed 'Willm Cox Devizes', the hood with swan neck pediment, glazed door and turned columns, above a rectangular trunk door, on a plain base and plinth, height 216cm, with pendulum and two weights.

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1153. The clock appears to be in generally good condition. The case has no significant damage or repairs, possibly originally bracket feet but now plinth. Trunk door in good order and locks. Dial has typical crazing to paint, but otherwise ok. Movement is very dirty, but all appears to be present, so a good clean should return to working order but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Very small layer of packing/padding to cheeks. No apparent woodworm. Pendulum with modern brass cover to bob and matching weights.
