1203. All a bit worn and dirty. The lacquered brass is heavily worn and scratched with some discolouration. Glass lenses appear to be ok. Rack and pinion focusing works as it should. Case worn and with splits to lid and base. Tripod ok but a bit dirty, scuffed etc.
