An early 19th century mahogany circular wall timepiece with brass eight day single fusee movement, the repainted 12-inch convex dial with black Roman hour numerals, within a moulded surround with cast brass bezel and convex glass, the case with hinged doors to side and underside, diameter 36.5cm (lacking pendulum).

1109. In generally good restored condition. Dial repainted. Glass and bezel in good order. Typical nicks and scuffs to edges. Restored veneer to both side and trap door. No pendulum.

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
