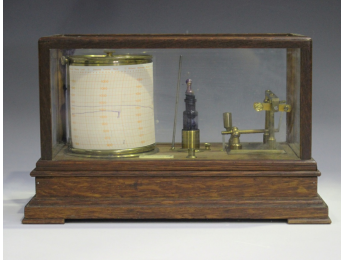

### LOT 1191

An early 20th century oak cased barograph with brass mechanism and clockwork recording drum, applied with a bone plaque detailed 'J. Lizard, Glasgow, London, Etc', the glazed cover on a moulded rectangular base, length 31.5cm.

### Condition Report

1191. Generally good condition but a bit dusty and dirty. Glazed case is dirty and has some ink stains to oak, but no significant damage or repairs. The oak stand in similar condition, but missing two back feet which have been replaced by a single pad in the centre to keep it stable. The clockwork drum movement winds smoothly and runs for a minute of two before stopping. Lacquered brass is a bit worn and missing its pointer arm.
