A late 19th century French rosewood carriage style mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the backplate stamped 'HRY Marc a Paris 8775', the signed engine turned silvered dial with black Roman hour numerals, the rectangular case with boxwood and satinwood inlaid foliate scroll decoration, beneath a cast brass carrying handle, height 23cm, with pendulum.

Condition Report

1132. The clock is in generally good clean condition with only typical minor scuffs and scratches to case, glass and metalwork. The clock winds smoothly and looks as though it should run but the silk suspension is broken, so not running at the moment. Key included.

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
