A Regency Scottish rosewood bracket clock with brass eight day twin fusee movement striking hours on a bell with pull repeat mechanism, the backplate inscribed 'WM Mitchell & Son Glasgow', within an engraved border, the silvered arch dial with strike/silent indicator above black Roman numerals, the case with moulded arch pediment and brass line inlaid decoration, the sides with embossed foliate and drop ring handles above pierced fret panels, the front door with brass inset cut corners, on a plinth base and brass ball feet, height 34cm, the pendulum with engraved bob.

Condition Report

1116. The clock is in good restored condition with no significant damage. Some typical splits to veneers and some minor repairs to veneer, most noticeable on edge of back door. The movement winds smoothly and runs, and striking mechanism on the hour working as it should, and pull repeat also working but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Case key present and non-original winding key with the Lot.
