A silver cased keywind open-faced pocket watch, the gilt movement detailed 'Waltham Mass 5293298', silver inner case, the signed enamelled dial with black Roman numerals and subsidiary seconds, Birmingham 1892, case diameter 5cm, with a watch Albert chain, fitted with a hook, a swivel and a silver fob medal, Birmingham 1918, and a key, chain length 35cm.

Condition Report

1003. The watch winds smoothly and runs but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Over an hour's test it keeps pretty good time.

Dial in generally good clean condition, but does have a faint hairline to edge of dial between 7 and 8 o'clock.

Case is ok, but worn particularly to back with numerous small dents. Both back and front hinges are good and close tightly.

Chain in generally good order with typical wear and surface scratches.
