A late 18th century mahogany decanter box with hinged top, the interior fitted with a set of six gilded glass decanters and stoppers, height 26cm, width 25cm.

Condition Report

2509. The exterior of the case has some typical minor scuffs and some very minor surface cracking to the veneer around the lower edges of the sides. Also some very minor lifting of veneer on the edge of the curve. The interior lining appears to be old but has been replaced at some stage with some slightly untidy edges to the interior of the lid. All the bottles and stoppers are in good condition, but do have some wear to the gilt, particularly on handles and rims. One of the stoppers is stuck and unable to pull out. There is a very slight warp to the lid so there is a small gap in the opening on the left side.
