A late George III mahogany chest-on-chest, the dentil moulded pediment above two short and six long oak-lined drawers, on bracket feet, height 170cm, width 107cm, depth 59cm.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

2220. The right-hand side upper section of the chest has a vertical crack running through the surface and the other sides have less substantial cracks. There is a small chunk of moulding missing to right-hand corner of middle moulding and a few other small chips to the veneer. There is a small chip to the veneer on the rear edge of the right rear foot, which appears to have some woodworm to the pine underneath. The feet have had some later blocks added to the internal corners for extra support. There is one circular handle backer missing but otherwise all handles and locks are present. There are a few areas of damage and loss to the cock beading.
