A late 19th/early 20th century burr walnut pop-up piano Davenport of unusual proportions, the galleried rising top enclosing a maple interior, the curved lid revealing three drawers and a pull-out writing surface, the side with four drawers, raised on carved supports and castors, height 122cm, width 73cm, depth 55cm.

### Condition Report

2017. The Davenport has the overall feel of a piece that has been made slightly out of period, even though the quality of the timber and veneer is still very good. Condition throughout is also very good with only a small chip to the handle of one of the pop-up drawers and some slight cracks to the veneer either side of the claw feet on the top surface of the base. Otherwise nicely polished and with the pop-up mechanism in good order, operated by the central dummy drawer handle to the interior.
