LOT 2012

A George III mahogany 'D'-end dining table with central drop-flap section and reeded edge top, raised on ring turned and reeded tapering legs, terminating in brass caps and castors, height 73cm, extended length 296cm, unextended length 178cm, depth 122cm.

Estimate: £800 - £1,200

Condition Report

2012. The table has been fully restored and re-polished at some point in the fairly recent history, but this has been done sympathetically leaving reasonable overall patina and colour. One of the drop-flap leaves has a slightly wavy edge, but is only minimal. There is a small strip of wood missing on the underside of one of the 'D' ends and it is slightly visible to the corner. There are a few very minor hairline cracks to the surface of the veneer around the curved frieze sections. Otherwise the table is in good order and appears to be structurally sound and sturdy. The underside has been fitted with replacement bolts that hold the brass leaf hinges in place.
