A late 19th century French onyx and spelter mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the dial with Arabic numerals, the onyx pedestal base surmounted with a figure of a young lady, height 50.5cm.

Condition Report

1142. The case is in generally good order, but is a bit dirty and dusty. Also few small chips to edge of onyx, cracks to front onyx panel and top panel. Two onyx side panels are loose, but just need gluing in place. These are all visible in the images available on our website. The movement does not wind or run but the strike does work on the hour.

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
