A late 19th century French gilt metal and porcelain mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the dial painted with a landscape within black Roman numeral border, the drum case with urn surmount, on paw feet, height 34.5cm, with pendulum.

Condition Report

1141. Case is a bit dirty and dusty, but otherwise ok with no significant damage or repairs. Porcelain panels in good order, but finial is a bit wobbly so would require tightening up. The movement winds smoothly and runs, and the strike mechanism is working, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

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
