LOT 1170

A George III Welsh oak and mahogany longcase clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the 13-inch square painted dial with Roman hour numerals, date aperture and subsidiary seconds dial, inscribed 'Griffith Llanfyllin', the hood with a moulded swan neck pediment above a glazed door, the trunk with rectangular panelled door flanked by columns, on a panelled base with bracket feet, height 222.5cm, with pendulum and two weights.

Estimate: £50 - £100

Condition Report

1170. Generally in fairly good overall condition. A bit dirty and dusty, and case and movement would benefit from a clean. Some typical rippling/lifting of veneer to hood and some splits/cracks to veneers on hood door. Otherwise case is ok, but missing front section of one bracket foot, small chip to corner of glass door and some signs of previous woodworm. Movement winds smoothly and runs for 5-10 minutes and then stops so a little bit of work/clean/refurbishment probably required.

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
