A late 19th/early 20th century French kingwood and thuya writing desk with overall applied gilt bronze mounts, the galleried top with two oak-lined drawers flanked by a pair of lifting doors, the frieze with cast cherubic panel flanked by two further drawers, on slender cabriole legs terminating in claw sabots, height 101cm, width 81cm, depth 58cm.

Condition Report

2040. Generally good order but with a slight crinkling of veneer to top surface, a crack to the veneer on right-hand side of sliding panel, as well as some slight movement to other areas of the veneer. Mounts are well cast and one sabot is loose. There is a bloom to the polish on the sliding surface.
